Northern Valley Packers are working with Second Bite to provide them with fruit that would otherwise be stock feed or waste. This fruit is fresh but not fit for the strict market quality, for example it is too large or too small, to lumpy or have some skin blemishes.



Usually in a week the great team at @secondbite - <https://www.secondbite.org/> - receive and process about 53,000kgs of food however with the help of the team at Northern Valley Packers they have reached a new high of over 65,000kgs of produce in a week which will go towards helping out over 35,000 people! How is that for amazing team work 🍌🍌.



There have been so many oranges that **schools have been able to collect the fruit to distribute to their students**. Our school thanks Mrs Hanna for loading up her car on Wednesday and delivering fifteen crates to us to share with you. Whoopee! This is a great initiative to open up discussions about food waste, market demand, local produce, people in our community who are food insecure and agencies out there helping.
