On the COVID front, Department of Education guidelines and processes for school operations, including communication to the school community of positive cases at school, continue to develop and improve in response to feedback. Please continue to watch for updates on CONNECT to stay informed and don't hesitate to contact myself or the school office to keep us informed of any COVID related developments on the home front.

We continue to improve our COVID-safe practices at school and have recently installed at bottle-refill tap on each of our drink fountains. Class teachers are encouraging students to refill their water bottle rather than drink from the fountain in the interest of reducing the spread of germs. We request that all students bring a refillable water bottle to school each day, clearly labelled with their name.

#### **SCHOOL POLICIES**

#### **School Dress Code**

At Tuart Hill Primary School all students are expected to wear our school uniform. This assists students in developing a positive self-image, encourages the development of pride in our school and provides a positive image to the local community.

#### **Dress Code Requirements**

- Red school shirts or T-shirts (collar preferred). No slogans or multi-coloured designs.
- School jumpers (with school logo), or plain red wind-cheaters.
- Black trousers or tracksuit pants
- Black skirts/skorts
- Black shorts
- A red broad brimmed hat (with school logo)
- Appropriate footwear closed in shoes e.g.: joggers, soft soled shoes or school shoes
- Stud or small sleeper earrings only.
- Denim clothing, flip-flop footwear, ugg boots, wellingtons, high heels or party wear is not permitted
- Makeup of any kind is not permitted and nail polish is strongly discouraged

#### **Modifications to the Dress Code**

Parents who, for religious or health reasons, may wish to modify the school dress code are required to make an appointment with the principal. Staff will be informed of any student granted a modification to the dress code.

Students not following the dress code may be denied the opportunity to represent their school at school activities, which include choir, excursions, sporting and social events.




#### Attendance




