Interm Swimming 2022

Interm Swimming is a school-based swimming program for children from Pre-primary to Year 6. It provides quality swimming lessons across the State to ensure children develop vital swimming and water safety skills. While experienced swimming teachers are provided by the Department of Education, parents / carers pay a fee to cover entry costs into the swimming venue.

In 2022 swimming lessons for students in PPA, PPB, PPC, Room 13, Room 14 and Room 15, will be held at **Terry Tzyack Leisure Centre from Monday 7 November to Friday 18 November**. Student will swim everyday (10 lessons). Students will travel to Terry Tzyack pool via bus, accompanied by classroom teachers, who hold duty of care and are responsible for supporting appropriate student engagement.

Cost

There is a cost of **\$66** for these 10 lessons (which includes the daily entrance cost to Terry Tzyack and bus costs) and **all students are expected to attend**. Please contact Mrs Beverly Innes if you have any concerns or queries. Payment options are outlined on the attached permission slip.

Students will need

- Bathers that include a rash shirt or old t-shirt as a swim shirt
- a towel
- **a second bathrobe / swimming pop-over**
- sandals/flip-flops/ slip ons for comfy easy safe walking to and from the pool
- a plastic bag for wet items
- goggles (optional)

Please label all students' belongings with your child's name.

Students will change at school with appropriate privacy and under appropriate supervision from class teachers before and after swimming lessons. **Teacher discretion applies at all times.**

Parents are welcome to meet us at the pool to watch their child/ren participate in swimming lessons, provided your presence enhances your child's learning and focus. There may be costs associated with spectators at the venue; please contact Terry Tzyack Leisure Centre for further information on this.

Special conditions

- All forms need to be returned.
- Students must be wearing footwear to and from their lessons and to go home.
- Students may not leave the pool with anyone other than their class teacher unless the parent /guardian presents the sign-out slip from the Front Office. This must be passed to the classroom teacher at the pool PRIOR to collection. **Students will not be allowed to leave the pool unless the parent/guardian presents the required yellow slip** as Swimming Lessons are part of the regular school day. This is a Department of Education legal requirement.
- In case of a parent needing to urgently contact their child/ren during swimming lessons please call the front office on 9413 1500 and the Teacher in Charge will be contacted.
- In case of any emergency staff will follow the Terry Tzyack Leisure Centre Emergency Procedures.
- Liability for loss or damage to student property and medical costs incurred in case of accident or illness or any costs incurred as a result of accident or illness are parent's responsibility. All care is taken and risk management is paramount. School staff members are not responsible for any loss or damage to your child's personal property that may occur during the course of the excursion.
