 <p><i>Artwork by Darryl Bellotti</i></p> <p>Djilba First Spring / August and September A transitional time of the year, Djilba has days that are very cold, some that are rainy and windy and others where the sun comes through. As the days start to warm up, you'll hear and see the first of the newborn animals with their parents providing them with food, shelter and protection from other animals and people. The woodland birds will still be nest bound, hence the swooping behaviour of the Koolbardi (magpie), Djidi Djidi (Willywag tails) and the Chuck-a-luck (wattle birds). This is the start of the massive flowering explosion in the Southwest. It begins with yellow flowering plants such as the Acacias. You'll also notice cream and striking blue coloured flowers. As the season progresses and the temperatures continue to rise, you will see the flower stalks of the Balgas (Grass Tress) emerging in preparation for the coming Kambarang season. Traditionally, the main food source at this time of the year included many of the land based grazing animals including Yongar (kangaroo), Waiitj (Emu) and the Koomal (possum).</p>

Science Week @ Tuart Hill Primary School Thursday 17 August 2020


This week we celebrated National Science Week 2023. On Thursday, our students participated in a STEM challenge, attempting to build the tallest tower structure they could, using limited materials.


To keep our beaches safe Sorrento Surf Lifesaving Club relies on its members for support.
