#### Science Week @ Tuart Hill Primary School Thursday 17 August 2020


This week we celebrated National Science Week 2023. On Thursday, our students participated in a STEM challenge, attempting to build the tallest tower structure they could, using limited materials.


We acknowledge and pay respect to the past, present and future traditional custodians of this boodja, the Wajuk Noongar people, who live, love and raise their koolangka here.

We had so much fun and hope you did too.




