 <p>Djilba First Spring / August and September A transitional time of the year, Djilba has days that are very cold, some that are rainy and windy and others where the sun comes through. As the days start to warm up, you'll hear and see the first of the newborn animals with their parents providing them with food, shelter and protection from other animals and people. The woodland birds will still be nest bound, hence the swooping behaviour of the Koolbardi (magpie), Djidi Djidi (Willywag tails) and the Chuck-a-luck (wattle birds). This is the start of the massive flowering explosion in the Southwest. It begins with yellow flowering plants such as the Acacias. You'll also notice cream and striking blue coloured flowers. As the season progresses and the temperatures continue to rise, you will see the flower stalks of the Balgas (Grass Tress) emerging in preparation for the coming Kambarang season. Traditionally, the main food source at this time of the year included many of the land based grazing animals including Yongar (kangaroo), Waitij (Emu) and the Koomal (possum).</p> <p><i>Artwork by Darryl Bellotti</i></p>

Tuart Hill PS enjoyed hosting a group of Taiwanese students that came all the way from the Dong Hwa Elementary School in Taiwan.

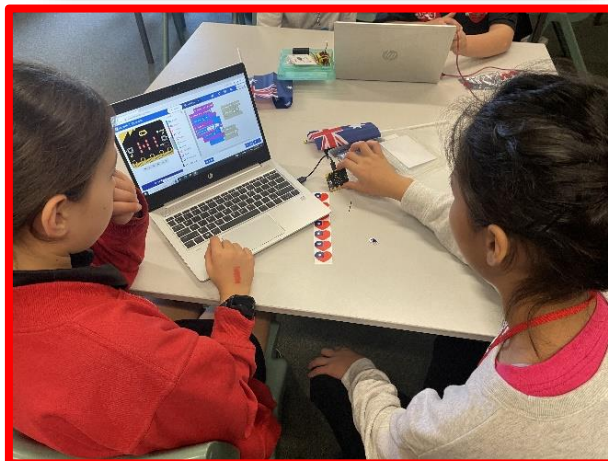

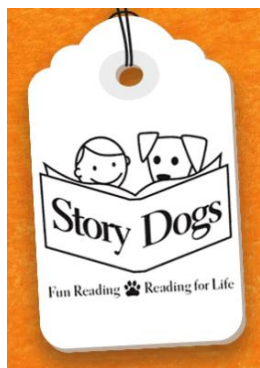
After the performance we were all extremely excited to start learning how to do it ourselves. Some of us were right on to it and got the tricks straight away but others were dropping it all over the place.
