Although the following contributions and charges are voluntary, funds enable the school to provide resources for your child. Payment by instalments can be arranged. Please contact the school office on (08) 9413 1500 for queries. Our office hours are 8.30am – 3.30pm. We thank you in advance for considering payment.

The Tuart Hill Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2024 at a meeting held on 26 October 2023. The schedule is broken into five sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year.

1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS (\$60.00 per child)

2. CHARGES

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions and activities for 2024 has been included in the schedule overleaf. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches. The **charges** schedule includes costs associated with specific learning activities that are made available to students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions.
