Easterly winds in the morning, followed by the afternoon sea breeze meant that traditionally, this was the time of year Noongar people burnt country. Please see me directly for a conversation if you have any questions around staff changes; thank you.

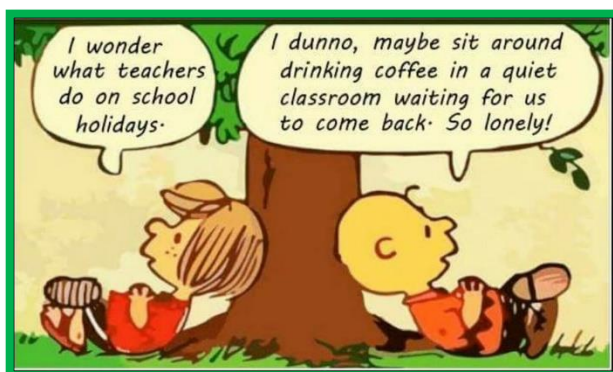
