<p><i>First Summer December and January</i> As the rains begin to ease, the warm weather of Birak starts to take hold with the afternoon sea breeze cooling those close to the ocean. Easterly winds in the morning, followed by the afternoon sea breeze meant that traditionally, this was the time of year Noongar people burnt country. 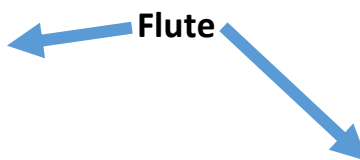

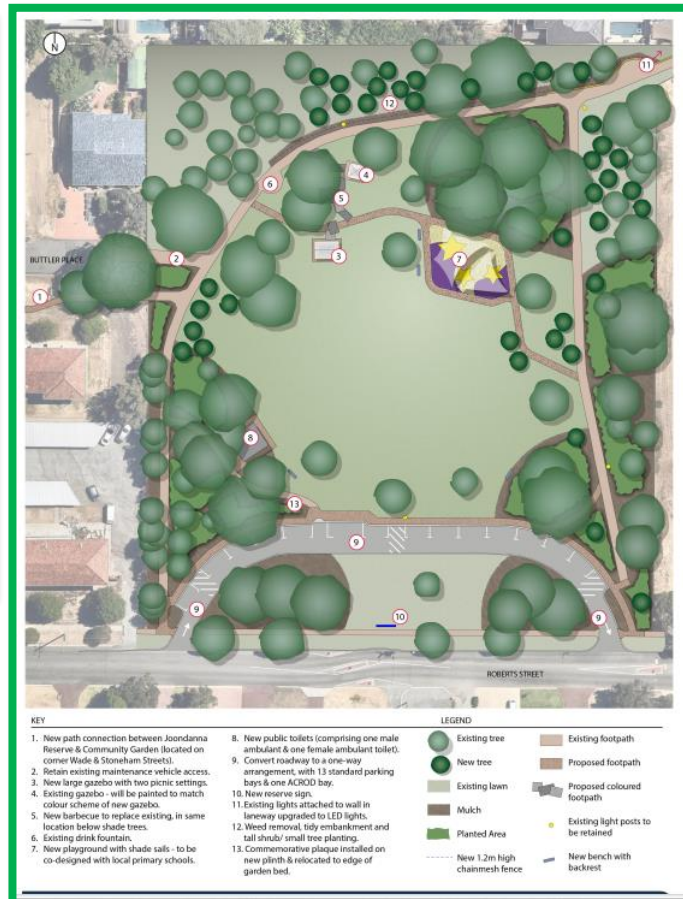
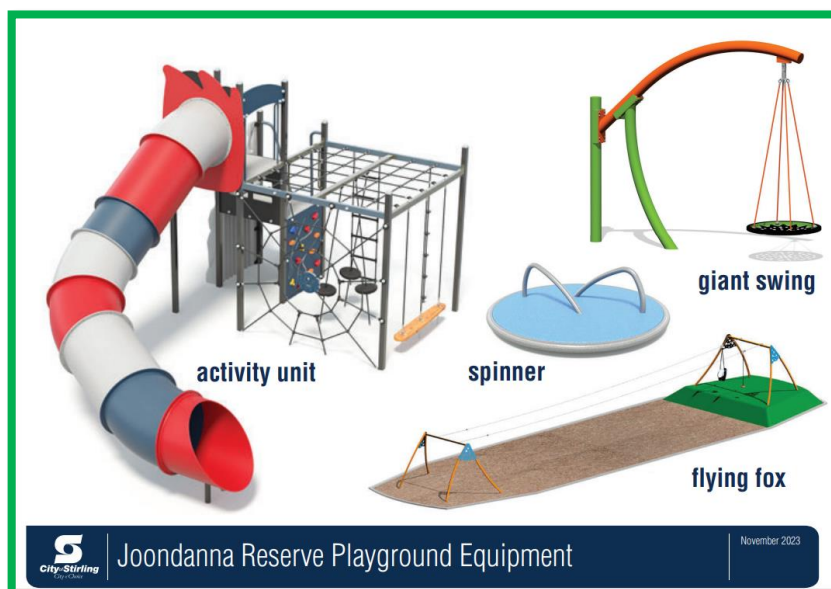

Student Leaders Consulted to Help Plan Joondanna Reserve Playground



Some representatives from the City of Stirling come to speak to Rm 21 a few weeks ago regarding seeking a local voice to advise on the upgrading of the nearby Joondanna Reserve.

Students gave thoughtful and considered responses to the visitors' questions. Our class has just been informed that most of the infrastructure suggested by the class made it into the final design, including several items that the council hadn't considered.

Cara Clifton, Senior Landscape Architect wrote that, as well as listing the elements the Planning Committee WOULD be including, 'There were some other suggestions such as seating, water fountains, toilets and picnic areas. These elements are all being included in the wider park upgrade as illustrated on the attached plan Joondanna Reserve - Landscape Concept.

There were also some additional suggestions that we hadn't considered such as bike parking and dog poo bags. Thank you for these suggestions – we will include them in the design going forward.

I am now preparing the playground design, taking into account the above feedback. Unfortunately the school term will be finished before the playground design is completed, however the students can keep up to date with the project through the City's website: <https://www.stirling.wa.gov.au/your-city/shaping-our-city/search-all-projects/joondanna-reserve-upgrade>

The upgrade is intended to be complete before the end of 2024, and I personally am quite proud of the students' input and maturity throughout the activity. A good learning experience all round!


P and C News
