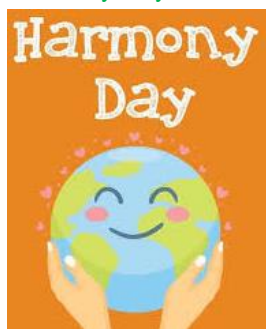
### After School Play
