Swimming Year 5 and 6

Our Year 5 and 6 students have now completed their two-week swimming instructions. Swimming lessons are an integral part of a child's education and we're proud of our Pre-Primary – Year 6 students who are now more skilled to be safe on, in and around water.



WHAT'S THE SHOW ABOUT?

Boodjar Kaatijin is a collection of Dreamtime stories which are based on Noongar knowledge and storytelling. Set in the Cold Time (*Nyitting Time*) audiences will join Koorlbardi (Magpie), Weitj (Emu), Nyingarn (Echidna) and their koordah (friends) as they journey through Noongar Boodjar sharing stories of how the land was created.

Through the sharing of Noongar language and important cultural knowledge and stories, *Boodjar Kaatijin* teaches us about The First Sunrise; The Creation of Kings Park; How the Kangaroo Got Its Colour; How the Echidna Got Its Spikes and the Creation of Wave Rock and the Stars.

Did you know ..

In Noongar language the word *Boodjar* means 'land' and the word *Kaatijin* means 'to learn', therefore, *Boodjar Kaatijin* means to 'learn about the land'.

Boodjar Kaatijin is one of four plays; *Kaarla Kaatijin*, *Djinda Kaatijin* & *Bilya Kaatijin*. Using Yirra Yaakin's website see if you can find the meaning of *Kaarla* and *Djinda* and *Bilya Kaatijin* and what the plays are about!





Free Broadband for Families

School Student Broadband Initiative provides free home internet for unconnected families with school-aged students until 31 December 2025.

To be eligible, families must:

- have no active broadband service,
- have a device capable of accessing the internet,
- live in premises where they can access a standard NBN service,
- have a child living at home who is enrolled in an Australian school.

Eligible families will be issued with a unique voucher which they can redeem with one of the participating internet providers. The free service begins when the service is activated.

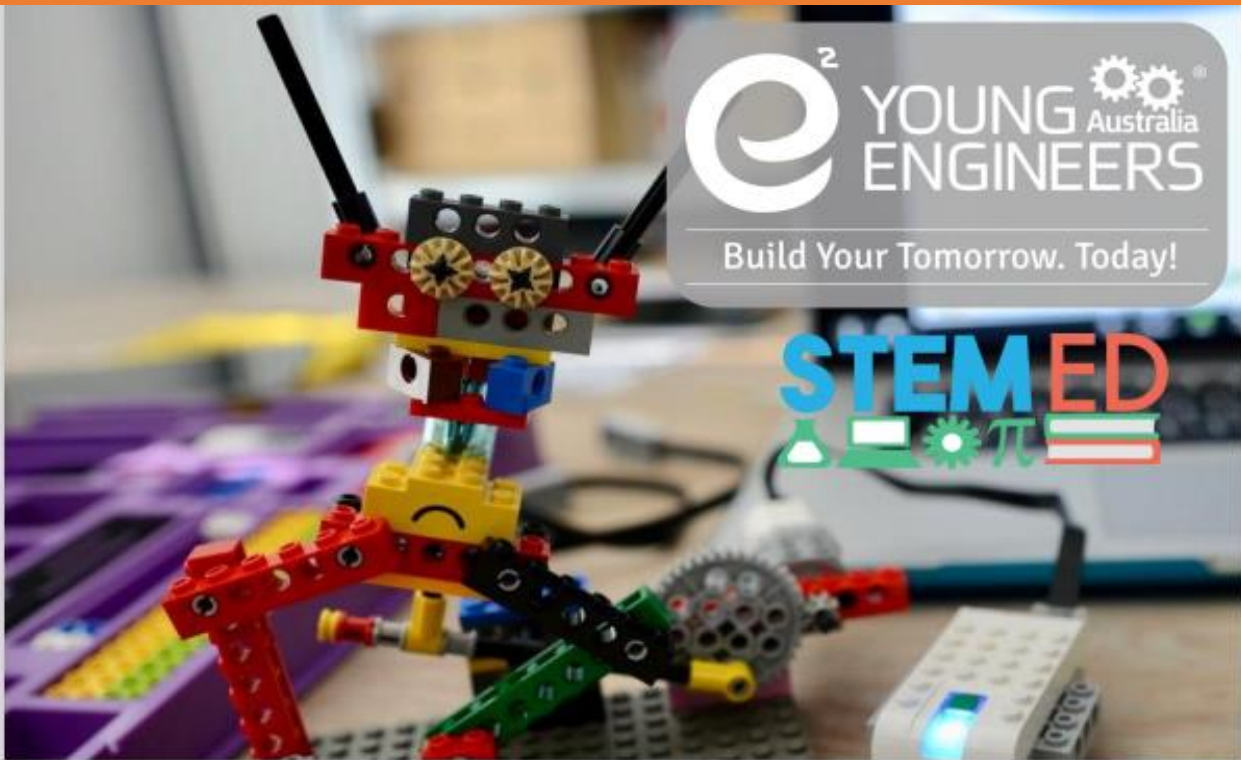
