#### From the Principal's Desk

#### Kaya to our school community

#### **Anaphylaxis** – we are **AWARE**, we **AVOID** triggers and **ACT** when necessary.

Anaphylaxis is the most severe form of allergic reaction and is potentially life threatening. It must be treated as a medical emergency, requiring immediate treatment and urgent medical attention.

Anaphylaxis is a generalised allergic reaction, which often involves more than one body system (e.g. skin, respiratory, gastro-intestinal and cardiovascular). A severe allergic reaction or anaphylaxis usually occurs within 20 minutes to 2 hours of exposure to the trigger and can rapidly become life threatening. <u>Detailed information around Allergies and Anaphylaxis</u> is available.

#### Tuart Hill Primary School is Anaphylaxis aware.

Many families live with the knowledge that unintentional contact with specific allergens can be fatal for their children.

The most common food allergy at our school is to NUTS. We ask that **NO NUTS nor NUT PRODUCTS** are brought onto the school grounds. One of our students has an anaphylactic reaction to the tiniest traces of nuts, such as those found in common chocolates – the families in that class have been made aware of this severe allergy.

It is our practice at Tuart Hill Primary School that class teachers clearly inform their parent group if a student lives with a specific allergy, with the permission and assistance of the parents of individual student/s. Parents overwhelmingly support each other to keep all our students safe by not sending those particular allergens in lunchboxes and bags – thank you.

Communication is the key to lowering parent and student anxiety around allergies. Please <u>contact me directly</u> if you would like me to raise class or whole school awareness of a diagnosed allergy so that together we can keep everyone safe at our school.

# Join the campaign to build a new 12-court stadium for Perth.

The Perth Basketball Association (Perth Redbacks) has recently launched an ambitious campaign. It petitions the State Government for the land and resources needed to build a new 12-

court sporting and mixed-use stadium for Perth.

The indoor courts situation in Perth is critical, leading to long wait lists for joining clubs, especially for basketball. Too many kids and families are missing out, and we need more courts in Perth to increase access and participation. For the Redbacks, this campaign is also about securing a home for the club for the first time in 60 years.

The campaign aims to reach 10,000 signatories on the petition, sending a compelling message to the government before the next election. Supporting the campaign is easy.
