Bringing Up Great Kids is an evidence based reflective parenting program developed by the Australian Childhood Foundation. Wanslea are offering this 6 week program to support parents raising children aged 0-12 years of age. Bringing Up Great Kids is run in a group environment to support you to:

- Learn about your parenting style and how it can be more effective
- Identify the important messages you want to convey to the children in your care and how to achieve this
- Learn more about brain development in children and how this influences their thoughts, feelings and behaviour
- Understand the meaning of children's behaviour
- Work out how to overcome some of the obstacles getting in the way of being the kind of parent you would like to be
- Discover ways to take care of yourself and find support when you need it.
