1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS (\$60.00 per child)

The total amount of voluntary contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained within the \$60.00 maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000. Your contribution will be used to supplement school funding for the purchase of resources needed in the provision of the learning program activities in the following areas.

English: Novels & Readers/Consumables Mathematics: Resources/Consumables

Science: Resources and Materials for activities HaSS (Humanities and Social Sciences): Resources

Art: Materials

Web based curriculum: materials/resources e.g. iPads and Mathletics.

While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our learning programs will be maximised when all families contribute.

2. CHARGES

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions and activities for 2025 has been included in the schedule below. The amounts indicated represent the **maximum** charged for scheduled activities in 2025. Students will only incur costs if/when they are involved in a particular activity. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches. The **charges** schedule includes costs associated with specific learning activities that are made available to students, but are conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions.
