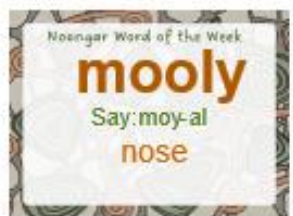

	<p>Makuru (June - July) The Noongar Season 'Makuru' is represented by the colour dark blue as it symbolises rain and cold weather. Makuru sees the coldest and wettest time of the year in the South West. Traditionally, this was a good time of the year to move back inland from the coast as the winds turned to the west and south bringing the cold weather, rains and occasionally snow on the peaks of the Stirling and Porongurup Ranges. As the waterways and catchments started to fill, people were able to move about their country with ease and their food sources changed from the sea, estuarine and lake foods to those of the land, in particular the grazing animals such as the kangaroo. As well as a food source, animals provided people with many other things. For example, the 'yongar' or kangaroo, not only provided meat but also 'bookas' (animal skin cloaks that were used as the nights became much cooler). Nothing was left. Even the bones and sinews were used in the manufacturing of bookas and for affixing barbs to hunting tools such as spears.</p>

Tuart Hill Primary School Acknowledges NAIDOC Week

This year's National NAIDOC Week marks 50 years of the week-long celebrations, and the theme, *The Next Generation: Strength, Vision & Legacy*, celebrates achievements of the past and the bright future ahead.

Our school welcomed Mr Len Yarran, a Noongar elder to complete a Welcome to Country Smoking ceremony at our school.

Mr Yarran spoke directly to all of us, as Australians living on Noongar land, and charged us all, regardless of heritage, with caring for the land, all nature, the people and particularly the children who now live on this land, Noongar country. Mr Yarran welcomed all who live here, and with the invitation to enjoy our wonderful place, this boodja, Tuart Hill Primary School and more widely on behalf of all indigenous people, Western Australia.

The whole school sang *Wanjoo* (Welcome) as well as *Heads, Shoulders Knees and Toes*, then *kaat, djerdim, boornitj, djena*, using our Term Two Noongar words.





Efforts to increase knowledge and understanding of the Noongar culture continued on Thursday 3 and Friday 4 July, when we invited 'Aunty' Liesha to lead our students in shared creative arts inspired by [Tjanpi desert weavers](#).

Students chose a cardboard outline of an animal and wove yarn around it, to cover the shape, guided by their individual creativity.



We collaborated in multiage groupings, demonstrating the sharing of knowledge and skills from older 'cousins' to younger children.



On behalf of us all, I extend thanks to our Cultural Committee for your planning and organisation of the Tuart Hill Primary School NAIDOC week, as these events will support inclusion of all in our communities.


