The Noongar Season 'Kambarang' (October – November) is represented by the colour yellow as it symbolises the return of the hot weather.

During Kambarang season, we see an abundance of colours and flowers exploding all around us.

The yellows of many of the acacias continue to abound, along with some of the banksias and many other smaller delicate flowering plants including the kangaroo paw and orchids. During this time the balgas will continue to flower, especially if they've been burnt in the past year or closely shaved.

One of the most striking displays of flowers to be seen during this season will be the moojar, or Australian Christmas Tree (*Nuytsia floribunda*). The bright orange-yellow flowers serve to signal the heat is on its way. October is also the most likely time of the year that you'll encounter a snake as the reptiles start to awaken from their hibernation and look to make the most of the warm to assist them in getting enough energy to look for food.

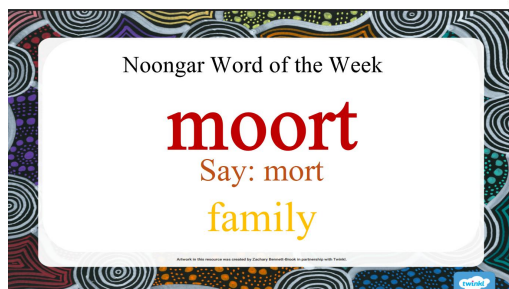
It's also a time that many young families of birds will be singing out for their parents to feed them.

Koolbardies (magpies) will be out protecting their nests and their babies. Many things are undergoing

### Playground Safety

This week a student suffered an accident before school that required surgery. We were all very shocked, and feel great empathy for the child and the family - this is not what you expect when you bring your child to school. I am sure you all join me in wishing the child a speedy recovery, and feel the anguish that the parents felt on receiving the phone call from us that their child had been hurt.

It transpired that the student was playing on a play structure without any supervision. No one saw the accident occur; luckily the Education Assistant heard the distressed student and looked out to investigate.

I remind all parents that **staff take duty of care at 8:30am**. Students must not play on equipment before school even if you are there. **Prior to 8:30am all students and their caregivers must wait in the Garden outside the Science Room.** All students are asked to sit quietly and responsibly until a member of the Admin Team supervise safe play on the Senior Oval, usually at 8:15am.

Please respect our teachers and educators by moving away from classrooms in the morning.

**Our Kindy and Pre-Primary student must be delivered by an adult directly and purposefully to the classroom educators.** This ensures the youngest students in our school are safe and closely supervised, as you would expect.

**Students and their carers are expected to leave the school promptly at 2:50pm.** The Outside of School Hours Care hire the school grounds from 2:50pm - 6:00pm; families need to leave playgrounds promptly. If you like to play and have social time, there are lots of parks available in our area. A siren sounds at 3:00pm to remind parents that OSH Care is about to use the playgrounds; please leave.

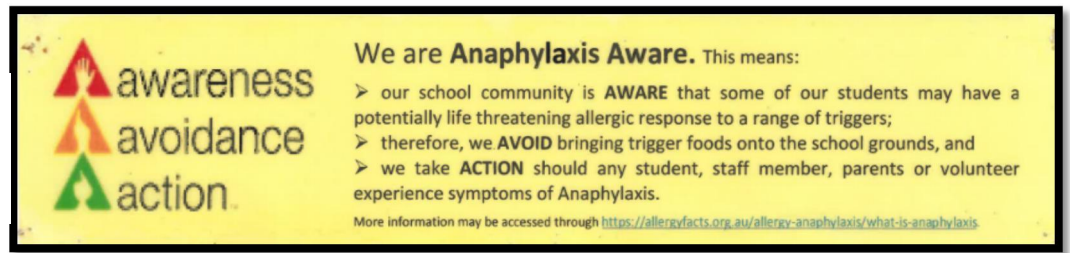
### Life Education
